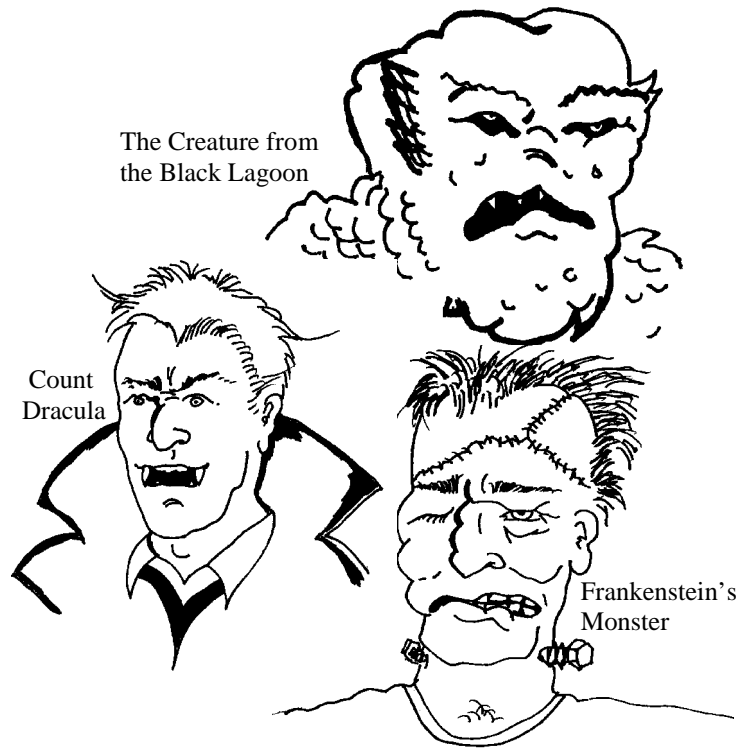
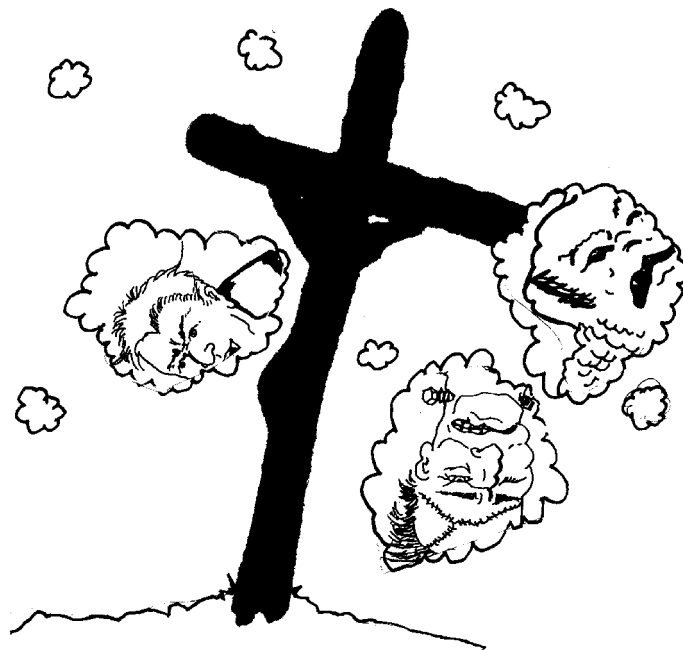


What do the following

(Jeremiah 29:11; Mark 8:35-37)

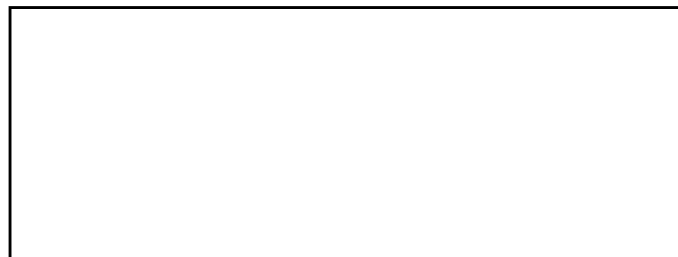
